We are very excited about Faith Kids Camp this year. We have many fun-filled events and activities planned for our campers. This will be our sixth year of providing a GREAT day camp program at Faith Assembly. Our staff professes to be followers of Christ, striving to live and adhere to the gospel message in John 3:16. Faith Kids Camp is part of Faith Assembly, which holds a General Council affiliation with the Assemblies of God church denomination.

We will again be offering a well organized "Leaders in Training" (LIT) camp, along with a strategically structured "Counselors in Training" (CIT) camp for teens entering the 7th through 10th grades. Our morning curriculum will involve camp chapel, where campers are introduced to various Bible stories, taught from an age-appropriate perspective. Later in the morning, campers will be treated to enriching activities such as, arts and crafts, cooking, environmental education, computers, sports, guest speakers, and spiritual development.
