

(K – 6th) School Age Camp Curriculum

Recreational Activities:

Each camp session will consist of daily educational activities such as environmental educational, arts and crafts, sports, cooking, computers, spiritual development, cool videos, guest speakers, camp barbeques, swimming, field trips and so much more! Field trips are offered to School-Age camp participants and take place throughout the Hudson Valley. Bowling, miniature golf, movies, the zoo, go-carts, visiting historical places, museums and the Fire House, are all part of our fun-filled and educational field trips.

Faith-Based Activities:

Each day campers will participate in Christ-centered and Bible-based devotions that are age appropriate. They will experience praise and worship music and learn to pray for themselves and one another as part of our camp chapel spiritual curriculum. It is recommended that School-Age campers bring their own personal Bible (with their name printed inside) that is easy to read and understand. School-Age campers who have not learned to read will be able to follow by listening or sitting with another camper who may point out what is being read.

It is our philosophy to introduce the scriptures at a young age. Use of the (NIV) or New Living Translation is recommended. Please note that all curriculum / teachings are aligned and affiliated with the Assemblies of God Church Denomination.
